

However, it is important as Eastern Stars we realize that the majority of us, or those we live with, take care of or associate with, are “vulnerable individuals” due to age and/or health concerns. At this time, restrictions remain in place that apply to us. Phase One reopening states: “Vulnerable individuals...should continue to shelter in place. Individuals who do go out should avoid socializing in groups of more than 10 people in places that lack appropriate social distancing; and nonessential travel is to be minimized.” Phase Two states: “...vulnerable individuals should continue to shelter in place. When people go out in public, they should avoid social settings with more than 50 people when appropriate social distancing is not practical.” Furthermore, the medical experts are expressing the distinct likelihood of a second wave of the virus.
